- Select the item. Click on the color and click on the size. (If you need help with sizing, click on the Size Chart link.)
- Enter your Preferred School Number in the School Code field and click "Confirm."
- If your school has a logo, you may apply it by highlighting it in the Logo Preference drop-down menu.\*\*
- Click Add to Bag.
- Review the product information in the pop-up box that appears and click "Keep Shopping" or "Check Out Now".

**GENERAL DRESS CODE INFORMATION**

---

- The Dress Code is descriptive—items not on the Dress Code are not permitted. Please be sure to follow the guidelines, including acceptable styles when there are several available.
- While AFA attempts to keep the information on the Lands' End web site current, the guidelines in this document always take precedence over what is on the Lands' End web site.
- Students are to dress modestly and neatly. Modesty involves not only having regard for the coverage and fit of clothes but also for the message that clothing sends. The requirement to be modest includes the stipulation that clothing should not call undue attention to itself or to its wearer.
- Clothing and accessories must be tasteful, clean, appropriately sized, and in good repair.
- Students must keep shirts tucked in at all times except for the ladies' 3/4 sleeve Oxford.
- Only white or gray undershirts are permitted.
- Undershirt (including turtleneck) sleeves must not be longer than the uniform top they are worn under.
- All sweaters, vests, and sweatshirts must be worn over a polo, oxford, or turtleneck.
- Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the waist.
- Belts are required with pants, shorts, and the two button skirt.
- Students may not wear hoods or hats indoors.
- Inside the school building, students may wear only approved sweaters or sweatshirts as listed in the uniform guidelines.
- Students may wear any coat, sweater, or sweatshirt outside during recess and P.E.
- The amount and style of jewelry must be modest and tasteful. Boys may not wear earrings. Neither boys nor girls may have any other piercings.
- Students are to keep their hair neat and brushed and out of their eyes. Boys' hair must be kept short enough that it is not touching the back collar of their shirts.
- Note that students will be required to wear their special events uniforms every Thursday.
- The Upper School Principal may waive the dress code for special events.
- The Upper School Principal is the arbiter of whether a student is in compliance with the dress code.

## REQUIRED PURCHASES FOR GIRLS

### Special Event Uniform (must be purchased by all girls)

- White 3/4 sleeve blouse with the AFA logo
- Khaki pleated skirt (**not** box pleat)
- Closed-toe dress shoes with a 2" heel or less, in solid black, dark brown or navy
- See Accessories section for legwear allowed with the Special Event Uniform.

### Required Field Trip Clothing (must be purchased by all girls)

- White polo shirt, long or short-sleeved with AFA logo OR special events uniform shirt.

- Khaki slacks or skirt
- Fleece and sweaters worn over the field trip uniform for added warmth must be from the approved daily wear uniform selections.

## OTHER OPTIONS FOR GIRLS DAILY WEAR UNIFORM

### Girls Daily Wear Tops (not all approved colors are displayed)

**Polo:** white, navy, evergreen or burgundy (long sleeve, short-sleeve; mesh, blend or interlock fabric; active fabric, regular or feminine fit, standard collar.



**Turtleneck/ Mock Turtleneck**  
white, navy, evergreen or burgundy



**Oxford / Blouse:** white, light blue  
long sleeve, short sleeve, ¾ sleeve  
**The white, ¾ sleeve blouse with logo is required for the female Special Event Uniform.**



**Sweatshirts:** navy, evergreen or burgundy  
crew neck only, no hood  
The sweatshirt must have the AFA logo.



**Fleece Zip-front Jacket:** navy, evergreen or burgundy  
The fleece jacket must have the AFA logo below.



**Sweaters**

white, navy, evergreen or burgundy zip-front drifter, button front drifter, v-neck drifter, fine gauge button front, drifter vest (hooded zip-front cable and short-sleeve fine gauge discontinued by Land's End.)



**Girls Daily Wear Bottoms**

**Pants:** khaki (Chino, or corduroy) plain front; pleated front; elastic waist; boot cut. **Pants:** Black (Ponte' Polyester)



**Shorts:** khaki (Chino or blend) plain front



**Skort:** khaki (Chino, blend or Active fabric)  
2 button stretch or long Chino or Polyester



Belts must be worn with pants, shorts and the 2 button skort.

**Skirts** (shorts may be worn under the skirt but must not be visible below the skirt)

**Pleated** (above the knee, **not** long) in khaki, black or hunter/navy plaid



**A-line** in khaki, black or hunter/navy plaid



## Girls Daily Wear Shoes

**Dress shoes:** closed-toe and closed back with 2" heel or less; solid dark brown, black or navy; (matching bow is fine, no glitter, metallic sheen, flowers, beads, feathers, clip-ons, i.e. "party on the feet.")

**Dress shoes required for the special event uniform.**



Examples that would not meet dress code:



**Athletic shoes:**

solid white with white laces  
(no other colors on them, or glitter, bows, etc.)

## Accessories

---

**With Dress Shoes:**

Natural colored hose; black, navy or white knee high socks; black, navy or white footed tights; navy or black leggings which extend to the ankles.



**With Athletic Shoes:**

White knee high socks; white ankle socks; white “no show socks”; or no socks or tights at all



**Belts Required with pants, shorts or 2 button skort:** braided or solid leather belt in brown or black (Lands’ End or exact match only)



**Hair Accessories:** Headband in solid white, navy, burgundy, evergreen, or hunter/navy plaid



## P.E. Uniform for 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Girls

---

If students have P.E. in the morning, they must wear their P.E. uniforms to school and, at lunch time, change into their regular uniforms for the remainder of the day. If they have P.E. after lunch, students must wear their regular AFA uniform to school and change into their P.E. uniform at lunch.

**Top:** AFA Polo, AFA active wear or spirit wear purchased through the Land’s End site.

**Bottom:** AFA uniform shorts or AFA athletic shorts from Land’s End with the AFA logo. Previously purchased AFA athletic shorts (discontinued by Land’s End) are permitted. Item #486479

**Bottom:** Solid navy, burgundy or black sweat pants. No writing, stripes or decoration is permitted on the sweat pants.

**Shoes:** athletic shoes are required.



Please keep in mind when making your size selection for athletic shorts from Land’s End that when a student is standing normally, the bottom of the shorts must be below the student’s fingertips.

## OPTIONAL SPIRIT WEAR FRIDAYS FOR GIRLS

Every Friday, students may choose either regular dress code tops or Spirit Wear tops purchased through the Land's End site using the preferred number 900147364.

All other items besides tops (bottoms, shoes, socks, accessories) must be regular dress code uniform items.

These tops may be purchased in navy or burgundy. All tops must have the spirit wear logo.



Short-sleeve t-shirt; Zip front hoodie; Long sleeve t-shirt; Crew sweatshirt; Pullover hoodie sweatshirt

## ATHLETIC SHORTS FOR GIRLS

Uniform Athletic Shorts and regular daily wear uniform shorts are the only shorts which may be worn for outdoor activities such as those during Spirit Week, House Olympiad and Field Day. The logo is required.
